

# Feeding, Cleaning and Socialization (FCS) Volunteer

FCS volunteers are scheduled one shift per week on the same day, same time, each week either for the morning shift or the evening shift. Morning shifts start as early as 8 a.m. Evening shifts start as early as 5 p.m. A typical shift is two hours. Most FCS shift are done in teams of two. This is a nice option for families that would enjoy working together. Some FCS volunteers are “back up volunteers” that cover open shifts as needed.

## Primary Duties

- Clean cages.
- Clean and refill food and water dishes.
- Clean and refill litter pans.
- Interacting with cats to ensure each cat gets some one on one time. Most cats enjoy coming out of their cage for some stretching and interactive play. Others are more comfortable remaining in the cages but enjoy petting and brushing.
- Complete daily log for each cat.
- Complete treatments as needed (eye or ear drops)
- Stock supplies as needed (food, litter)
- Sweep and mop floors at end of shift as well as sanitize all other hard surfaces
